## PASS PROGRAM



PASS (Parental After School Support Program) is an after school program designed to provide an environment that will enable your child to feel welcome and secure. The PASS Program offers a variety of activities, recreation, exercise and quiet time for homework. **The program is held at Byrd and Fry Schools from 2:35 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. on full attendance days.** The PASS Program begins on the first full day of school. Students in kindergarten through sixth grade are eligible to enroll in the PASS Program.

Burbank and Kennedy students will be bussed to Byrd. Maddock, McCord, and Tobin students will be bussed to Fry.

**The weekly fee for the PASS Program is \$35.00 per student.**

Payments are collected on a weekly or monthly basis and calculated based on the number of weeks the program is in session. Please note, whether your child attends PASS one day a week or five days a week, the fee is the same.

*The PASS Program does not accept subsidies, state benefits, or publicly funded child care programs (i.e. Action for Children, Head Start, IDHS programs, DCFS programs.)*
