Board of Education Meeting Summary

- Prior to the regular meeting, the board had a special meeting for a construction kick-off with the architects from Cannon Design. The architects presented modern design ideas and discussed current trends in education. It was an interactive and collaborative meeting. - Liberty's Class of 2016 Valedictorian Matthew Diaz and Salutatorian Isaac Lunar were recognized at the board meeting for their outstanding academic success. Matthew and Isaac received plaques and STAR pins.
- The board of education recognized the winners of the art exhibition. Each student received a medallion and STAR pin. Their work is now framed and displayed in the board room.
- Students from Burbank, Fry, Liberty, McCord, and Tobin were recognized by the Illinois Principals Association as outstanding students. They were recognized by the board and given a STAR pins for their achievements.
- Denise Flavin gave a brief presentation on Liberty's Career Day which was held April 29. She also showed a video highlighting the day's events.
- Joe Matise updated the board on SELF insurance renewal, E-Rate Application, Working Cash Fund transfer, prevailing wage and bonds for Burbank School.
- Summer help employees were approved.
- Student teacher placements for 2016-17 were approved.
- The board adopted AERO's FY17 budget.
- The board adopted the Resolution providing for the issue of \$27,000,000 in general obligation school bonds for the construction of a new Burbank School and executed the Bond Purchase Agreement.
