June 27, 2018

Board of Education Meeting Summary

- The board recognized the Liberty Junior High School Class of 2018 Valedictorian Gabriel Sanchez and Salutatorian Ryan Butnariu. The students were given a plaque and STAR student recognition pin for their outstanding achievements.
- Dr. Abousweilem gave a brief presentation on the Fifth Annual Multicultural Night, which was held April 26. She also shared a video slide show highlighting the evening's activities and performances.
- Dr. Abousweilem spoke about the KaBOOM! Playground Build Day and thanked everyone for volunteering. Ms. Gonzalez spoke about how they plan to utilize the playground and sport court as part of the curriculum. Ms. Mueller shared a video slide show from build day which included a time lapse of the entire project as well as a short clip from Mike Golic's talk show. Special thanks were given to Ms. Mueller for her hard work and dedication throughout the entire project from the application process through build day.
- Ms. Lindemann reviewed current vacancies throughout the district. She mentioned that staff in need of CPR/First Aid Training for coaching positions had their certificates renewed this month. She also said that the first session of summer school will be wrapping up on June 28 and the second session is set to begin on July 23.
- Ms. Flavin reviewed her recommendations to purchase Naglieri Non-Verbal Ability Test to use for the Acceleration Act as well as Reflex Math and Carnegie Learning coaching days. She announced that the social studies materials have arrived and will be sorted over the next few weeks. Ms. Flavin also spoke about her attendance at the International Society for Technology in Education National Conference.
- On behalf of the Business Office, Mr. Conboy announced that Arbor was the lowest responsible bidder for food service.
- On behalf of the Buildings & Grounds Department, Mr. Conboy said that all summer projects are on schedule to be finished by July 27. He said that New Burbank School would be completed on Friday and then deep cleaned, with furniture installation starting after July 10. He said that asbestos abatement at Old Burbank School will be completed by June 2 and police and fire department training will take place that week.
- Mr. McCartney said that New Burbank School is connected for wireless and phone systems. He said that new phones have been installed at Liberty and they are working on the one-to-one and refresh devices, which have arrived. He also said that they are doing a Power School upgrade as well as single sign-on and auto-rostering for Wonders.
- Dr. Gunnell from AERO Special Education Cooperative was present and spoke about AERO's purchase of Queen of Peace and answered questions about their FY19 budget.

- The board approved lane changes for the 2018-19 school year.
- The board approved an out of state field trip for Burbank School.
- The board approved summer camp coaches for 2018.
- The board approved coaches and sponsors for the 2018-19 school year.
- The recommendations for curriculum programs and professional development were approved.
- AERO's FY19 budget was approved.
- The food service bid was awarded to Arbor Management.
- The Bond Resolution was adopted.
- The board adopted for first reading the policy changes as recommended by IASB.
- The board approved the destruction of closed session tapes from 5/25/16 – 12/21/16.
