Board of Education Meeting Summary

- The top five St. Baldrick's Day fundraisers were recognized by the board of education. With special thanks to our numerous event organizers, 100 sponsors, 40 ponytail donors, and 75 shavees, we are proud to announce that the total amount raised this year was \$47,870.81.
- District 111's Third Annual Multicultural Night was held April 14. A video highlighting the evening's events was shared and has been posted under news on the district website.
- Dr. Fleck announced that District 111 has received two \$15,000 grants for Ben Carson Reading Rooms from Advocate Christ Medical Center and the Carson Scholars Fund. The Reading Rooms are at Kennedy and Maddock Schools. The grand opening ceremonies will be held May 2.
