

# Burbank School District 111 2021-22 School Year

## MEALS

District 111 operates a federally funded USDA breakfast/lunch program in all buildings. A monthly menu is sent home and can also be accessed on the District 111 web site, by clicking on District Info. Children must follow breakfast/lunch rules and procedures as established by the school. In accordance with the U.S.D.A., students may not share components of the school breakfast/lunch program.

All District 111 students will be issued a Student ID Card on a breakaway lanyard. The Student ID Card is used as the meal debit card. Students are expected to maintain a positive balance on their meal debit card at all times. Funds deposited to a student's account are non-refundable except for students transferring or graduating (only when there are no other outstanding fees/balances due). Notification will be sent to parents when the account balance falls to a low level. Negative balances may result in alternative meals. Delinquent fees may be turned over to a collection agency and/or carried over to the following year.

**The USDA has authorized school districts to provide free meals to all students on student attendance days throughout the 2021-2022 school year.**

## FREE/REDUCED BREAKFAST AND LUNCH PROGRAM

**Although meals will be free for all students for the 2021-22 school year, we are encouraging all families who believe they may be eligible for free or reduced lunch to submit a free lunch application. Students approved for free/reduced lunch automatically receive a waiver of student registration fees.** The State is also using the free lunch status to determine additional benefits such as Pandemic EBT.

## NEW ONLINE PARENT PORTAL SYSTEM: TITAN SCHOOL SOLUTIONS

We are happy to announce that the district has started utilizing a new parent portal system where you can view your students' meals account. You must go to <https://family.titank12.com> and create a new parent account in order to manage your students' meals. You can also submit a meal application through TITAN School Solutions for the current school year. Click on "**Sign up today!**" to begin the process of making a new account and be sure to have the following information to successfully link your student(s) to your account:

- First Name
- Last Name
- Date of Birth

Free lunch applications may be submitted at any time during the school year.

- Your child may qualify for the free/reduced breakfast/lunch program if your household income falls within the limits established by the Federal Income Chart.
- Free and Reduced-Price School Meals Application Forms must be completed annually.
- Foster children are eligible upon completion of the Free and Reduced-Price School Meals Application form.
- Do not submit more than one application per family.
- Do not submit if you are direct certified.
- Please allow up to four weeks for processing.
