Dear Parents and Guardians,

Burbank School District 111 is reopening using a multi-tiered, phased approach to bring students back for in-person learning. Many variables have been considered when determining the best process for the BSD111 Return to Learn Plan. Phase 1 of our program began on January 25, 2021. It included our Early Childhood/Pre-Kindergarten students, Kindergarten students, and students with specific learning needs.

Monday, February 1, will now be a remote learning planning day for teachers in grades 1-8 in order to prepare for the next phase of the Return to Learn Plan. You will be contacted by your student's teacher regarding student attendance expectations for that day.

In Phase 2 of our Return to Learn Plan, students enrolled in the hybrid program in grade 8 will begin in-person learning the week of Monday, February 8, 2021.

In Phase 3 of our Return to Learn Plan, students enrolled in the hybrid program in grades 6-7 will begin in-person learning the week of Monday, February 22, 2021.

Liberty Junior High School students will be divided into two groups (A & B) on a hybrid schedule. Please see the attached A/B schedule. This schedule allows us to stay within the recommended social distancing guidelines in the classrooms.

The school will open at 8:30 am and students will begin class at 8:40 am. Dismissal will be at 12:50 pm and all students will be required to connect remotely with afternoon classes from 2:20 to 3:30 pm. Dr. Abousweilem will be contacting you with additional details regarding this plan.

Please visit the district website for information on bus routes and grab & go meal distribution.

At Liberty Junior High School, students will remain in their grade level team/cohort. Every effort was made to keep grade level teams/cohorts and assigned classroom spaces in the same building zone. A team/cohort group is a group of people who interact regularly. A zone is a portion of the building where staff and students most frequently travel.

In addition, every effort has been made to develop and improve systems to support learning for all students whether in-person or remote learners. The goal of Burbank School District 111 is to have all students enrolled in the hybrid program back in school for in-person instruction by February 22, 2021.
